The recipient of this award's sense of humor and selflessness remind us of what sports are all about as she is willing to show her creative side both in the classroom and on the athletic field. |

The recipient will have demonstrated their commitment to the field of education through their extra-curricular and/or community activities. The student will be represented by his/her strong academic achievement, and financial need may be a determining factor. | 1 student | \$2,500 | EDDIE KEADY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP -will be awarded to a graduate who has demonstrated tenacity in their achievements, despite overcoming difficult circumstances that have impacted their lives. The recipient should be someone who is not recognized as top in his or her class, but has invested in him or herself through effort and determination. The applicant should be in an organized sport. Please include a brief, one-page essay describing the learning, physical or emotional limitations that you have had to overcome and how you have done so. |

1 student	\$2,500	GEORGE H. MORSE MEMORIAL WORLD LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded annually to a graduating senior who while in high school has demonstrated high academic achievement and extraordinary interest in the study of world language. The recipient must plan to continue that study at an institution of higher learning.
1 girl	\$2,500	NINA ALEXA PANSUK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be presented to a girl who is interested in continuing her studies in the field of communications, public relations, or journalism at the college level. The recipient should show a concern for others in the community and school by service and activities in these areas. Energy and enthusiasm should also be a characteristic, and these qualities should show forth in her activities. The recipient should be accepted at an institution of higher learning.
1 girl	\$2,000	CATHERINE CURTIS WINKLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded each year to a senior female Needham High School graduate who has exhibited superior scholastic achievement, strong character and leadership abilities, and who plans to attend a four-year liberal arts college. The recipient must also have demonstrated outstanding achievement/promise in Literature and/or Creative Writing.
1 student	\$2,000	CATHERINE MARGARET WHARTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduate who has demonstrated sensitivity and compassion in his/her personal relationships and consistent motivation to achieve at a higher level than expected despite a learning, physical, or emotional limitation. The recipient should be someone who ordinarily might not have received recognition as a top performer, yet who has invested in his/her work a similar level of effort and determination. Special consideration should be given to a student with a strong interest in art or drafting. The recipient must have been accepted at a college, technical school, or other institute of higher learning. Please include a brief, one-page essay describing what learning, physical, or emotional limitations you have had to overcome and how you have done so.
1 student	\$2,000	BETH ISRAEL DEACONESS HOSPITAL AID ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a student graduating from Needham High School who wishes to further his/her education in a health-related field and is accepted to an institution of higher learning. Based on financial need and good character, candidate must be in the top half of the class.

1 girl	\$2,000	NEW CENTURY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is available to a girl of the senior high school graduating class who qualifies for admission to a classical or vocational institution of learning. The award is based on good scholastic ability and accomplishment, need of financial assistance, good character and citizenship, demonstrates service and leadership and certainty of admission to a college.
1 student	\$2,000	RICHARD T. FOLEY, SR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP sponsored by the Needham Firefighters' Local 1706, will be presented to a senior who has a C average or better, is a recipient of a varsity letter in baseball or softball, and has been accepted at an institution of higher learning. First preference will be given to a student in need of financial assistance to further his/her education. (\$1,000 - 1st year) (\$1,000 - 2nd year)
1 girl	\$1,500	ALISON CHRISTINE DESROCHES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a female student who has been accepted a post secondary institution. The recipient will have made a substantial contribution to the community through her involvement in athletics and music. She should have also demonstrated determination in overcoming some obstacle, academic, physical, or emotional. Please describe in a brief, one-page essay how you overcame this obstacle.
1 student	\$1,500	CENTURY 21 THE ALEXANDERS SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a graduate who has been accepted in an institution of higher education. The candidates should have a good balance between academic achievement and school involvement in student activities. Financial need may be a determining factor. All applicants will be required to submit a brief, one-page essay describing their educational goals and areas of interest.
1 student	\$1,500	MARK ROBERT BEANE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded annually to a member of the graduating class who has been a contributing member of an organized high school or community music group. In addition, the student must have earned a varsity letter in interscholastic athletics. She/he must have maintained a "B" average, or better, in a challenging academic program. She/he must be well-liked and respected by classmates and faculty. The recipient must have been accepted at an institution of higher learning.
1 student	\$1,200	LURIE ANN GERBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded each year to a student in the graduating class who has faced or is facing a difficult challenge (i.e.: personal, medical, emotional). A brief, one page essay about the challenge should accompany the application. All applicants should have participated in community/school activities and received acceptance at an institution of higher learning. Class standing will not be a factor for selection.

1 student	\$1,200	GEORGE F. SKINNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduating senior at Needham High School who has been accepted at a two or four year institution of higher learning. He/she should be an all-around student who demonstrates a strong character, a positive attitude, and his/her determination to succeed at his/her goals. Eagerness to learn and leadership qualities should be a consideration. Participation in school activities and community service may also be a consideration.
1 student	\$1,100	NEEDHAM EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduating senior who intends to enter the field of education or human services. The committee will be looking for someone who has shown a concern for others, a good academic record and a dedication to public service.
1 student	\$1,000	NEEDHAM EXCHANGE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a Needham High School senior who is a resident of Needham and who will be attending a two or four-year post high school educational program, college or university. The scholarship is based on the following criteria: the recipient must be of excellent character, motivated, and have maintained a good scholastic record despite having overcome difficult circumstances that may have affected his/her life. Participation in school activities, community service, and financial need may be a consideration.
1 student	\$1,000	ADAM S. COLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be presented to a senior who exemplifies good personal qualities and is keenly interested in furthering his/her educational goals through determination and effort. He/she must be respected by classmates and faculty and have been accepted at an institution of higher learning. It will be given to a student with average grades interested in pursuing a career in aviation, flight mechanics or auto mechanics. The recipient must be in need of financial assistance.
1 student	\$1,000	CAMBRIDGEPORT BANK SOCIAL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a graduating senior planning to attend college who has made an outstanding contribution to the community or school in the area of social service. Requirements include a letter of recommendation from supervisor of service program, whether community or school.
1 student	\$1,000	DAVID TURNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded annually to one senior who has plans for education beyond high school and who has financial need.

1 student	\$1,000	DEFAZIO FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who exemplifies good personal qualities and is keenly interested in furthering his/her educational goals through determination and effort. Preference will be given first to children of Needham School Department employees or, second, to children of Town of Needham employees. Special consideration will be given to students interested in pursuing a career in education or a career in the dental health field. Although financial need is not a determining factor, it may be a consideration.
1 student	\$1,000	GARRETT J. CULLEN III MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded annually to a member of the graduating class at Needham High School who has taken an active part in extra-curricular activities in school and/or in the community. The recipient must rank in the upper half of the class and must attend an institution of higher learning in the succeeding semester. Financial need is not a factor.
1 student	\$1,000	GILBERT G. MacDONALD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been accepted to Northeastern University. The person selected must possess a strong character and be active in clubs and/or activities at NHS. Attitude and determination take precedence over academic achievement and financial need in selecting the recipient.
1 student	\$1,000	GOLD'S GYM SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF ARTHUR WALTZMAN is presented annually to a member of the graduation class who has been an all around student, maintained at least a B average, shown leadership, and provided service to the community. The recipient should also participate in a variety of extra-curricular activities including varsity letters in two different sports and have been accepted at a four-year institution of higher learning.
1 student	\$1,000	THE MARYANN DOLAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a graduating senior, who has been accepted to a four-year college and is an outstanding student. The candidate should have an interest in Public Service with special consideration in pursuing Government, Education and International Affairs. The qualified candidate shall have exhibited leadership roles within the community and school environments.

1 student	\$1,000	<p>JAIME MCKEOWN The Jamie McKeown Memorial Scholarship Fund seeks to reward applicants who share the same qualities and values that Jamie possessed. The recipient must have been accepted at a four-year institution of higher learning.</p>
1 student	\$1,000	<p>JUSTIN M. EILBERG SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduating senior at Needham High School. The recipient should demonstrate a desire to overcome challenging personal and/or academic problems. Special consideration will be given to a student who has shown the ability to deal with these circumstances and are moving forward in his/her daily life. Factors that would add to the attractiveness of the candidate's application would be if he/she has a sincere love of the game of baseball, a genuine concern for the preservation of nature, as well as an exhibited compassion for the animal kingdom.</p>
1 student	\$1,000	<p>KAREN SULLIVAN DECEMBRELE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a student who has done well in high school, participated in numerous activities, and contributed significantly to the school community despite overcoming obstacles presented by a family and/or medical situation. Financial need is not a consideration.</p>

1 student	\$1,000	MIDDLESEX SAVINGS BANK SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a student graduating from Needham High School who is accepted to an institution of higher learning. The candidate should be of average scholastic standing, possess good character and have financial need.
4 students	\$1,000	NEEDHAM BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded to two senior boys and two senior girls selected by the Needham Booster Club. The student must have participated in high school athletics and earned at least one varsity letter and participated in at least two Booster Club fund drives. The student shall have demonstrated the will to win combined with good sportsmanship. The student must have made successful application to an institution of higher learning that requires a high school diploma for admission. Financial need is not a prime consideration for this scholarship.
1 student	\$1,000	NEEDHAM GARDEN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is presented to a graduating senior who has been accepted at an accredited institute of higher learning and intends to pursue a course of study in such fields as horticulture, conservation, or the environmental sciences.
1 student	\$1,000	NEEDHAM POLICE UNION SCHOLARSHIP is given annually to a member of the graduating class at Needham High School who plans to continue his or her education in the field of criminal justice or a related field. The recipient should have participated in school and/or community activities in which they have served in a leadership role and made a contribution to the activity. Preference will be given to students whose parents have been employed in the field of criminal justice. (\$500 - 1st year) (\$500 - 2nd year)
1 student	\$1,000	NEEDHAM WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior residing in Needham who wishes to further their education and are accepted to an institution of higher learning. Selection is based on good scholastic ability, need of financial assistance, and demonstrated community service.
1 student	\$1,000	NEEDHAM WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF PEGGY KEITH is awarded to a senior residing in Needham who wishes to pursue a career in the Allied Health Profession and is accepted to an institution of higher learning. Selection is based on good scholastic ability, need of financial assistance, and demonstrated community service.
1 boy	\$1,000	NEEDHAM YOUTH LACROSSE (BOYS) SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a Needham High School senior who intends on continuing his education full time at an institution of higher learning. The recipient must have played on either the NHS junior varsity or varsity boys' lacrosse team. Preference will be given to seniors who are also alumni of the Needham Youth Lacrosse -

Boys League. On your application, please list all the youth and high school lacrosse programs you have participated in. The recipient must exhibit a love for lacrosse, demonstrate teamwork on and off the field, be involved in the community, and have high athletic and academic achievements.

3 students	\$1,000	NEHOIDEN LODGE AF & AM SCHOLARSHIPS will be presented to three seniors who have maintained good scholastic standing during their high school years. Financial need may be a consideration.
1 girl	\$1,000	PAMELA TRUSSELL DUGGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a girl who is respected by classmates and faculty, has shown a concern for others by service to school or community, and is energetic and enthusiastic about life. These characteristics should carry over into those activities that she pursues. She should be accepted at an institution of higher learning.
1 student	\$1,000	POSTCOMER'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is awarded annually to a member of the graduating class at Needham High School whose parents have been residents of Needham for two years or more. The recipient should have taken an active part in extra-curricular activities in school and/or in the community. The recipient's rank in class is not a determining factor. However, she/he must attend an institution of higher learning in the succeeding fall semester.
1 student	\$1,000	RICHARD TODD SACKS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP Richard Sacks was a person who had a true entrepreneurial spirit. He had a likeable and charismatic personality. Rich entered every challenge and activity with enthusiasm. Richard was a NHS graduate, class of 1986. The person selected should be a high school senior and accepted in a school of higher learning with an opportunity to major in business. Consideration will be given to individuals for their academic achievements and extra curricular activities. Financial need will not be a consideration.
8 students	\$1,000	ROBERT L. RIMMELE SCHOLARSHIPS -provides a sum of money yearly to award scholarships for further education beyond the high school level for Needham residents who are high school graduates. This fund was established through the generosity of the late Robert L. Rimmele to assist Needham residents in furthering their education.
1 student	\$1,000	RONALD R. DESROCHES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is presented to a Needham High School senior who has exhibited a spirit of volunteerism and has participated in sports. The recipient should also have an interest in music and a good scholastic record.
1 student	\$1,000	SEAN JOSEPH CAFFREY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is presented annually to a member of the graduating class who has been involved in the Needham Youth Soccer Program and/or the Boston Area Youth Soccer

League. The recipient may be an average student whose energy and enthusiasm for life is to take him/her on to a two or four-year college program. The recipient should have need for financial assistance.

2 students	\$1,000	STACEY LYN NIELSEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to 2 seniors who have demonstrated a love of life, a commitment to achievement, and a passionate spirit in areas of involvement at Needham High School. The recipient must have a sincere and determined interest in furthering his/her education. Special consideration should be given to a student who has displayed an inner strength in the face of adversity.
1 student	\$1,000	TIMOTHY PATRICK FLANAGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is given to a Needham High School senior who has lettered in lacrosse and loves the sport. He or she must be an all-around student, liked by classmates, possessing a quick wit, and a sense of adventure. The recipient must be a person who enters into every activity with enthusiasm, who leads by example, and who has worked hard to improve skills - who is more an Indian than a Chief. The recipient must have been accepted and be attending an institution of higher education before the scholarship is awarded. The scholarship will be distributed for the second semester of the freshman year in college.
1 student	\$750	MIRIAM KRONISH FINE AND PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who has participated in fine and performing arts activities in any venue during their high school career. In addition, the student should have demonstrated respect for their peers and teachers and contributed to positive school citizenship. Furthermore, the recipient should be in good academic standing with a demonstrated financial need. The scholarship will be awarded pending acceptance to an accredited institution of higher learning. Factors that would add to the attractiveness of the candidate's application would be a sincere love of the arts, a genuine concern for mankind, as well as a demonstrated passion for learning.
1 student	\$500	CHESTNUT DENTAL ASSOCIATES SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who has a good academic record, participated in school activities, and is interested in a career in the medical/dental field.
1 student	\$500	EDWARD J. KASPIK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a Needham High School graduate who wishes to pursue the study of music either through private lessons or in an institution of higher learning. Selection is based upon a demonstrated interest in music and desire to develop one's talent while sharing it with others.
1 student	\$500	EDWARD J. STEWART MEMORIAL 13 CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who has maintained a record of good school citizenship, have a

GPA of at least 2.5, and has been accepted to an institution of higher learning.

1 girl	\$500	GREG SEES BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior girl who has participated in the St. Joseph's Basketball Program. The recipient must have actively done volunteer work or service work in the community.
1 student	\$500	JOSEPH PAULINI SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduate who has demonstrated tenacity in their academic and athletic achievements, although not necessarily recognized as top in his class or as an "all-star" on the field or ice. The recipient should show a concern for others in the school and in the community by service and activities in these areas: Selflessness, friendliness, respects others, intensity and enthusiasm should also be characteristics of the recipient. The recipient must participate in varsity soccer or hockey.
1 student	\$500	MICHAEL CHALLIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a senior who has maintained a B or better average and possesses abilities and motivation which enable enthusiastic participation in interscholastic sports and other school activities. Financial need is a consideration, and the student must have been accepted at an institution of higher education.
8 students	\$500	NEEDHAM HIGH SCHOOL PARENT TEACHER COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIPS are awarded to members of the graduating class who have been active leaders in school or community extra-curricular activities. The students must have maintained at least a B average during their junior and senior years of high school and been accepted at an institution of higher learning. Financial need is not a determining factor, however, the student must have demonstrated concern for the welfare of others and been an active worker in worthwhile activities. (Awarded to 4 boys and 4 girls)
1 student	\$500	NEEDHAM DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ACTION COMMITTEE The Needham Domestic Violence Action Committee award is given to a NHS graduating senior who plans to attend an institute of higher learning in the fall. The graduate must have demonstrated an awareness and sensitivity about the rights of others by having participated in a project educating the community about such rights. Preference will be given to a student whose work included domestic violence and sexual assault issues.
2 students	\$500	NEEDHAM LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS are awarded to two Needham High School seniors who will be graduating from high school and are residents of Needham, based on the following criteria: need, scholastic record, extra-curricular activities, community interests, and personality.

1 student	\$500	NEEDHAM SCOUTERS' CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is given to a senior who has shown good character, citizenship, leadership, and participation in community service and has an interest in environmental issues.
1 girl	\$500	PATRICIA CRUICKSHANK GIRLS' SOFTBALL SCHOLARSHIP is presented to a senior girl who has participated or volunteered in the Needham Girls' Softball League during her high school years. The recipient should also have participated in Needham High School athletics and be a Needham resident.
8 students	\$750	ROY T. JOHAN TOUCHDOWN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP is awarded annually to student-athletes who will be attending a post secondary school and have participated in the football or cheerleading program for a minimum of three years. Eligible seniors must submit a brief, one-page essay with their application telling about their cheerleading/football experience.
1 student	\$500	RUTHANNE B. SIMMONS, M.D. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a graduating senior who has: (1) demonstrated excellence in the sciences; (2) made valuable humanitarian contributions to the community; and (3) exhibited a positive and cheerful attitude with friends, classmates, teachers, supervisors, and family. The criteria will be determined by school record and one letter of recommendation, which is to be from a science teacher (or similar mentor in the sciences) with first-hand knowledge of the applicant's contributions to the community.
1 student	\$500	STANLEY WILLOX MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded each year to a graduating senior who has participated in the Boston Area Youth Soccer League. He or she must be attending a two or four-year college and have shown true sportsmanship and courtesy on and off the field.
1 student	\$500	WILLIAM T. BURKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a senior who has been active in town or school sports and has been accepted by an accredited two or four year post secondary school. Academic grades will not necessarily be a prerequisite. Financial need is a factor in the selection.
1 student	\$500	WINGATE AT NEEDHAM SCHOLARSHIP is presented to a senior who has a good scholastic record, has participated in school/community activities, and is planning a career in a healthcare field. The recipient should plan to spend a day at the Wingate facility after the scholarship is presented.
1 student	\$350	DANA F. BURKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior accepted at an institution of higher learning that has participated in interscholastic golf, been a good team member, displayed good sportsmanship and good school citizenship.

1 student	\$300	HELEN R. CAINE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a member of the graduating class of Needham High School who plans to pursue a career in early childhood or elementary education. The recipient will have been accepted to an institution of higher learning for the coming school year. He/she must be an all-around student of strong character, charitable toward others, and has demonstrated an interest in the education of young children.
1 student	\$300	REBECCA H. PERRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP established by the Harris School Parent Teachers' Club is awarded to a high school senior. The scholarship is available to a student who is certain of admission to an institution of higher learning and is based on scholastic achievement, good character and responsible citizenship. The money is to be used the year following high school graduation and not be held in reserve.
Varies	\$300-\$2,000	DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. SCHOLARSHIPS are presented to up to nine senior students of color who have demonstrated good citizenship and have been accepted to a two or four-year college.
1 student	\$250	"KIDS ARE GREAT" SCHOLARSHIP AWARD IN MEMORY OF LEO F. RICHARDS, JR. is awarded to student who is a member of the Needham High School football team or cheerleading squad. He or she must have played or cheered two consecutive years in Pop Warner. Preference will be given to a student who submits a one-page essay on their experience as a football player or cheerleader and what is meant to them should accompany the application.
1 student	\$250	MOSELEY SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a member of the senior class of Needham High School intending to continue study at a higher institution of learning and whose record shows constant and consistent high marks in attendance, deportment, and scholarship, along so-called cultural lines.
2 students	\$250	NEEDHAM COMMUNITY THEATER AWARDS are presented to two seniors, preferably a boy and a girl, who have maintained good academic records and participated in performing arts in the school and/or community. Preference should be given to students who intend to continue in some area of the performing arts following high school graduation.
1 boy	\$250	STEVEN C. WERNICK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior boy who has shown outstanding achievement in mathematics. He should be an all-around good student and have participated in school activities.

2 students \$250 (1 boy and 1 girl)	THOMAS W. EASTMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS will be awarded annually to a boy and a girl who are members of the graduating class at Needham High School who have demonstrated interest in biology and/or environmental sciences. Students must attend an institution of higher learning in the succeeding fall semester.
1 student \$200	ANITA M. REINKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who has shown outstanding ability in the field of music. The student must have been accepted by a higher institution of learning to major in music or in Applied Vocal Training. This senior should be one who has made an outstanding contribution to the Needham High School chorus, orchestra, or band.
2 students \$200 (1 boy and 1 girl)	MITCHELL SCHOOL NATALENE TAVALONE SCHOLARSHIPS are given to two deserving students who attended the Mitchell School for at least one year and have plans for higher education.
1 student \$200	NEEDHAM PSYCHOTHERAPY ASSOCIATES SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a senior who would like to pursue a career in psychiatry, psychology, social work or a related mental health field. The recipient should be a student who has good scholastic standing and who has shown commitment to community service.
