Each year, NCE provides over 500 different enrichment programs to over 6,000 participants including Needham's elementary, middle and high school students, as well as adults living and working in Needham and the surrounding communities. NCE is committed to delivering quality lifelong experiences for all.

IMPORTANT regarding NHS winter sports: If there is any chance that your child will be trying out for or joining an NHS winter sports team, they cannot register for the Ski & Snowboard Club. MIAA rules prohibit winter high school athletes from participating in a club sport program as well. If your child were to make a winter sports team, NCE cannot provide a refund.

Program is open to Advanced Beginner-Expert Skiers only: Due to a Wachusett Mountain policy, we are unable to accept beginner skiers/boarders in this program.

Withdrawal Policy: There are no refunds or credits for withdrawals once a registration has been completed. All participants must commit to the Ski & Snowboard Club program. If you anticipate having conflicts, please do not enroll in the program.




Lost and Found
